The PSU Bicycle Cooperative is an Alternative Transportation Program administered through the Parking & Transportation Services Dept. of PSU. It is the aim of the PSU Bicycle Cooperative to encourage and empower all students, faculty, staff and alumni that choose to commute and/or recreate by bike. The PSU Bicycle Cooperative seeks to achieve that goal through the teaching of mechanical self-sufficiency and proper repair techniques, as well as providing an inexpensive resource for the parts and supplies necessary to maintain bicycles for the purpose of transportation.

All members must adhere to the following rules:

- Always be safe. Your safety and the safety of those around you are paramount. Members are expected to utilize the shop space and it's tools in a safe and cautious manner at all times.
- Be courteous. All members will be expected to treat those around them with respect and courteousness. Patience also falls under this category.
- Be helpful. Being helpful has two components. 1) When the right opportunity arises, please be helpful to fellow members and Co-Op staff. 2) When you need help, for any reason, make sure that you ask. If you need help and don't ask, you risk damaging both your bike and our tools.
- All tools and Co-Op items must remain at the Co-Op. Members will not be allowed to remove anything from the Co-Op without purchasing it first. Tools are not for sale, rent, or loan.
- All tools and equipment must be returned to their proper place when you are finished using them.
- Please clean your workspace when you have finished using it. Any parts removed or disassembled are your responsibility: please remove them or recycle them.

Membership to the PSU Bicycle Cooperative shall include the following benefits:

- Use of available shop space and tools during hours of operation.
- Assistance from Co-Op Staff and Volunteers
- Discounted purchase of available merchandise
- Discount on enrollment in Co-Op workshops and seminars
- Access daily secured bike parking at the Co-Op (Available 7am-6:30pm Mon-Thurs, 7am – 5pm Fri)
